## COASTAL LANDSCAPE SHOTS

- Shots from high vantage points
- Rough seas, crashing waves
- Coastal marshes, tidal flats
- Beaches, dunes
- Intertidal zone
- Fog shrouded coastal forests
- Coastal cliffs

## FLORA AND FAUNA

- Close ups/eye catching shots of COSEWIC listed coastal plain flora species (eg. thread-leaved sundew, Eastern White Cedar, Long's Bulrush, Boreal Felt Lichen etc.)
- Floodplain forest rare plants and Wood Turtles (found at St. Mary's River)
- Waterfowl—close ups, pair shots or congregations (harlequin ducks, eiders, goldeneyes etc.)
- Shorebirds—close ups, or flock shots (all the plovers [particularly piping], all sandpipers, yellowlegs, roseate terns, etc.)
